ConAgra Manager Elected Vice President

Bart Hahlweg, plant manager for ConAgra Foods Inc. in Oakland, Calif., was unanimously elected 2009-2010 vice president of the International Association of Operative Millers (IAOM) at the association's 113th annual conference and expo on April 30 in Grand Rapids, Mich. As vice president, Hahlweg will be responsible for overseeing preparations for the association's 2010 conference in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Hahlweg has been an active member of IAOM since 1992. He served on the executive committee as treasurer in 2008-2009. He was director of IAOM's Golden West District from 2005 to 2008; and served as that district's chairman from 2002-2004. He also served as the Southeastern District's chairman from 1997-1998. While serving as IAOM treasurer, Hahlweg will also be president of the International Milling Education Foundation (IMEF), a philanthropic partner of IAOM that funds a variety of educational programs related to the grain milling industry. Hahlweg has been an IMEF trustee since 2005.

Hahlweg completed his bachelor's of science degree in agricultural business at Colorado State University, Ft. Collins, Colo., in 1989. He joined ConAgra Foods upon graduation. Over the course of his career at ConAgra, Hahlweg has worked in six different facilities as operations analyst, scheduling supervisor, associate miller, elevator/packaging supervisor, and plant manager. His first plant manager appointment came in 1993 in Blackwell, Okla., followed by three years managing the company's Tampa, Florida, plant. He has been the Oakland facility's plant manager since 1998.
