Educational Presentation Subject Areas

The IAOM Conference format features presentations within the following four broad categories. For the 2012 Conference, IAOM will be seeking presenters to fill seven, 30-minute time slots for the four tracks. The educational sessions will be held on the afternoons of Wednesday, May 9 and Thursday, May 10. IAOM anticipates audiences of approximately 50-100 for each of the presentations.

Employee Management (EM) = Covers aspects of employee management (i.e. recruitment, retention, motivation, safety)

Facility Management (FM) = Covers aspects of operations related to facility design, construction, maintenance and equipment evaluation and acquisition.

Product Protection (PP) = Covers aspects of sanitation, food protection, food safety, finished product testing, storage and transportation.

Technical Operations (TO) = Covers aspects related to the technical aspects of raw product evaluation, testing, storage and processing.
