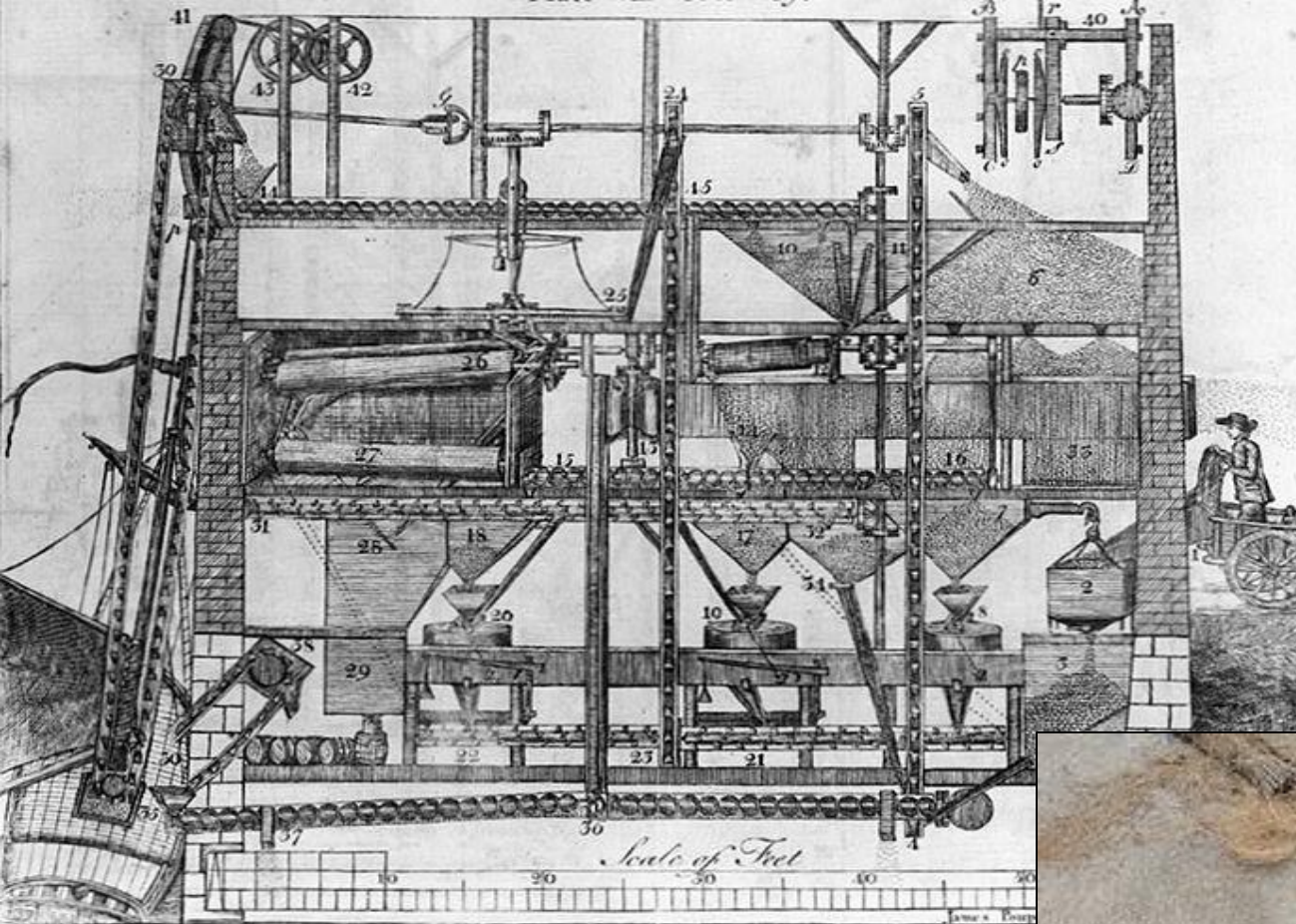

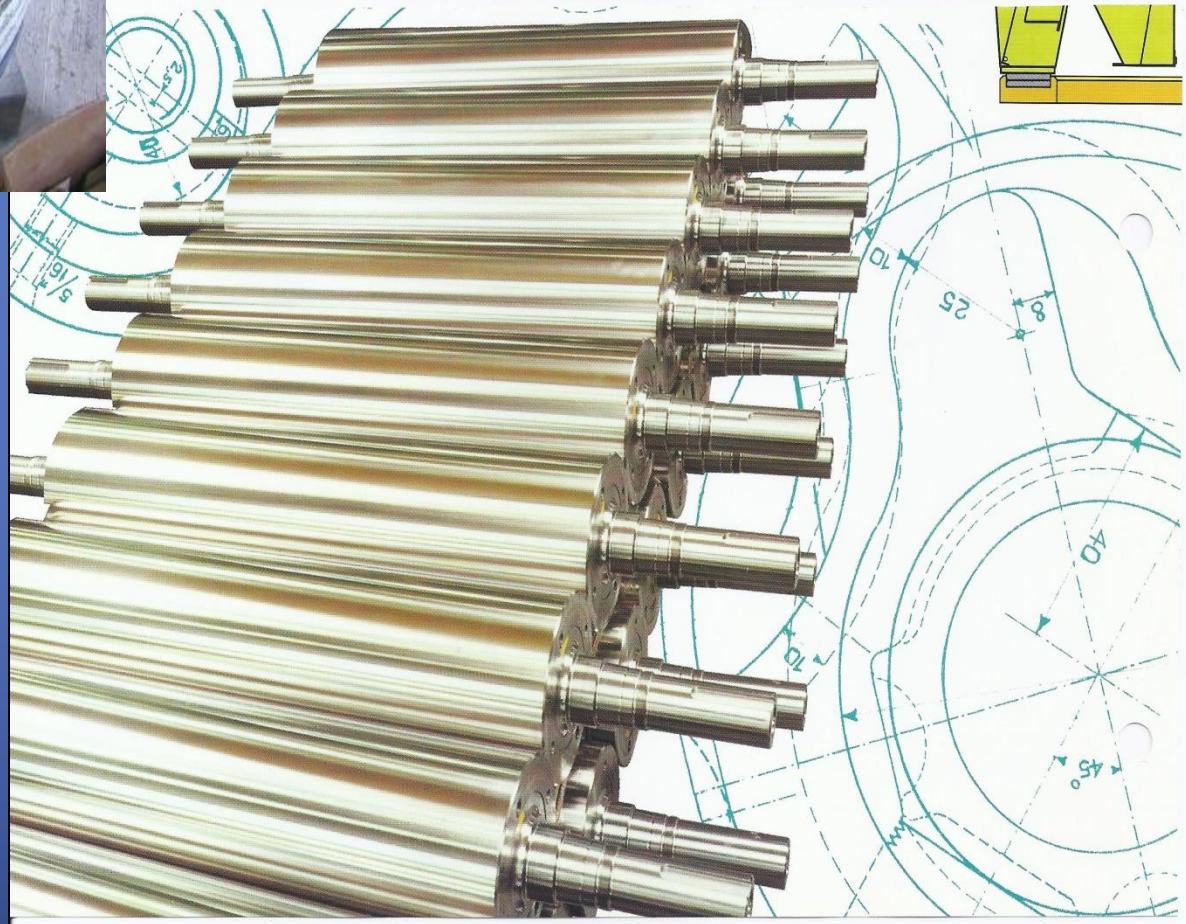

One of the outstanding mills in Southeast United States with one of the outstanding pneumatic conveying systems in the milling industry. The mill is Interstate Milling Company of Charlotte, North Carolina. The system is by Kice, typical of nearly 100 similar pneumatic systems now operating in some 40 mills throughout North America. Interstate is the fourth mill in the same group of mills completely converted to Pneumatix by Kice, plus scores

The above picture was taken on the top floor of the mill. The cyclone separators were again formed on a special lathe by an exclusive Kice process that assures peak efficiency, especially when handling small micron size particles that are lost by ordinary cyclones. The airlocks feature ductile iron rotors, permanently lubricated triple sealed bearings and precision machining. Note the sanitary airlock mounting benches and the beautiful installation of Kice Speed Spout that extends through the entire mill.

Not shown in the photo is the 100 H.P. two stage Kice Multi Blower which supplies the air power for all of the suction lifts in this 4,000 cu.ft. mill. Developed especially for the tough applications in American mills, the Kice Multiblower has proven itself over the past ten years. Another feature not shown is the exclusive Kice Streamguard at the start of each lift. This simple device rejects excessive loads of stock - thus preventing system chokes.

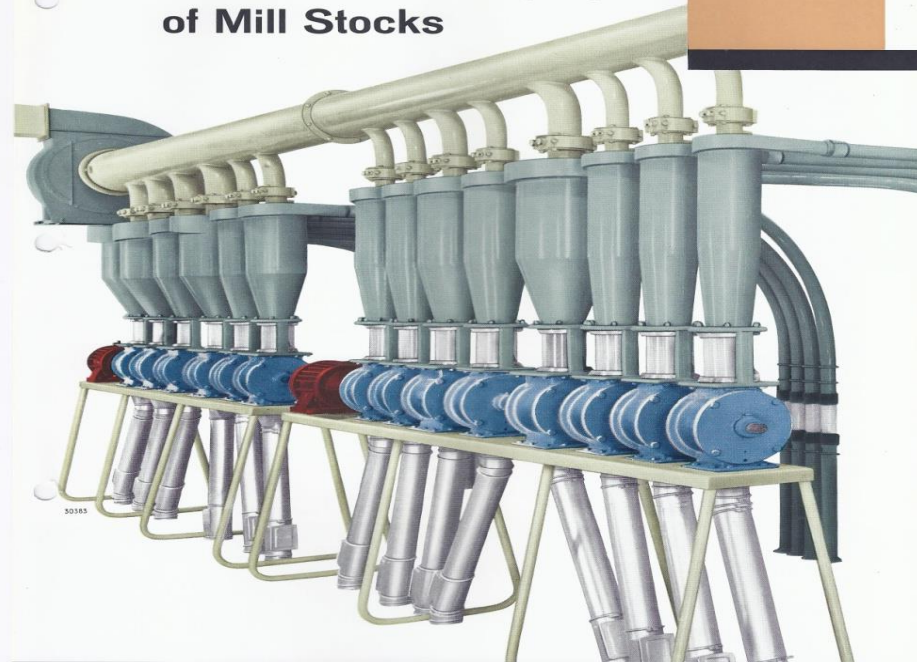
In addition to negative pressure systems shown the Kice Pneumatic line includes positive pressure and combination systems including portable units in a complete range of sizes from 1/2 to 100 h.p. - capacities to 100 tons per hour.
