## **Educational Presentation Subject Areas**

The IAOM Conference format features presentations within the following five broad categories. For the 2020 Conference, IAOM will be seeking presenters to fill six, 30-minute time slots for the four simultaneous tracks. The educational sessions will be held on Wednesday, April 8 and Thursday, April 9. IAOM anticipates audiences of approximately 50-100 for each of the presentations.

***Employee Management (EM)*** = Covers aspects of employee management (i.e. recruitment, retention, motivation, safety).

***Facility Management (FM)*** = Covers aspects of operations related to facility design, construction, maintenance and equipment evaluation and acquisition.

***Product Protection (PP)*** = Covers aspects of sanitation, food protection, food safety, finished product testing, storage and transportation.

***Technical Operations (TO)*** = Covers aspects related to the technical aspects of raw product evaluation, testing, storage and processing.

***Specialty Milling (SM)*** = Covers all aspects related to milling grains other than wheat.
